

New labour codes and their impact

Industry expectation survey

The most recent labour laws were drafted decades ago and the changes in economic development, global trade conditions, new forms of doing business, etc., over the years, have made it necessary to relook at these laws with a fresh perspective. The four new labour codes – Code on Wages, 2019; The Code on Social Security, 2020; The Occupational Safety, Health & Working Conditions Code, 2020; and The Industrial Relations Code 2020; which subsume 29 existing legislation, are the first step in the direction of bringing in labour reforms across the country. The date of implementation is expected to be notified soon.
